

HFMC Preschool Covid-19 Precautions

**updated Nov 2020 as per provincial protocols*

- Our classes are capped at 16 students for the 4 year old class and 15 for the 3 year old class
- *Meet the Teacher* night is being replaced with an online option via Zoom
- There will be staggered drop-off times
- After class pick-up will be at the door – each child will be brought to the door and walked to the curb for drive up pick-up
- Avoid prolonged pick-up and drop-offs (if you need to discuss something with the teacher, make arrangements via phone call or email)
- While waiting for the class to start and end please wait in your car and not in the foyer
- One caregiver at a time for drop off (to limit number of people)
- Parents should remain in the foyer and are not permitted upstairs
- Masks are mandatory inside the building
- If your child or any member of your household (except teething babies or toddlers) has fever, runny nose or cough, or any other symptoms of Covid, the child must stay home – use the screening tool here: <https://public.ehealthsask.ca/sites/COVID-19/>
- If you plan to vacation outside of Saskatchewan, your child is welcome back after a 14-day self isolation (no tuition adjustments will be given)
- Each student will use their own pencils, crayons, and glue sticks
- All communal art items will be sanitized between uses
- Each child will have their own Ziploc bag of playdoh
- Hand Washing/Sanitizing Practices:
 - Upon arrival (everyone entering the building must do so)
 - Before sensory play
 - Before/after snack
 - Before free play
- Toys will be disinfected after each class and as needed, along with scheduled additional deep cleaning of toys
- Tables will be cleaned after use; all other surfaces will be cleaned after each class
- Snack time will take place in the open area outside the preschool room. Children and tables will be adequately spaced at safe distances
- NO TOYS BROUGHT FROM HOME ARE PERMITTED

Please note that these precautions will change and update according to our Health Authority and GSCS School Board Regulations.
